BENEFITS OF HOSTING

Join us for a Business After Hours (BAH), an evening dedicated to elevated networking and highlighting your business. This unveils a precious opportunity for weaving connections among both new and seasoned members. It serves as an opportunity to intertwine your business with the community, elevate your brand's presence, and potentially summon leads and sales from the gathering of attendees.



HOW TO PREPARE

Hosts should be prepared to welcome a crowd of 75 to 100 guests in a warm reception atmosphere, whether indoors or under an outdoor tent. Hosts must provide:

- ✔ An array of 2–3 hot and cold refreshment selections
- ✔ Beer, wine, and non-alcoholic beverages
- ✔ Light catering (appetizers, hors d'oeuvres, or small bites)
- ✔ A speaker to welcome guests and educate members on your business
- ✔ Marketing materials and special promotions or raffles



SUMMER MONTHS REQUIREMENTS

Due to the heat, all events hosted during the months of May – September are required to be held indoors.

How to Get Started

Select an available month, and let's begin our planning! You will take the lead in organizing your BAH by arranging tables, drinks, food, and light catering. We will extend invitations to all our Chamber Members, Chamber Board & Ambassadors, as well as City & County officials. Additionally, we will promote the event on our social media platforms and our website.

HOSTING OPTIONS & SPONSORSHIP LEVELS
